Reflection:

- 1) In Mark 8:21–22, Jesus teaches about old and new wineskins to show that people need to be fundamentally changed in order be in right relationship with him. Have your group share ways in which God has changed their life through salvation, making them like new wineskins.
- 2) Answer Jesus' question in verse 9 for yourself. What is easier for you to believe: "Your sins are forgiven," or "You are healed from paralysis"? Why?

- 3) Looking at v17-22, what would Jesus say is the basic character of people in the world?
- 4) Based upon this passage, do you think you can earn your salvation by being a good person? How does this make you feel?
- 5) In verses 32-34, Jesus says that he is going to die. According to verse 45, what is the purpose of his death?
- 6) Read Isaiah 53:5, 10-12. How do these verses help us understand what a ransom is?
- 7) What would Jesus tell you to do if you desired to enter into a relationship with God?
