⁹ And he said, “Go, and say to this people:

^d“ ‘Keep on hearing,³ but do not understand;

keep on seeing,⁴ but do not perceive.’

¹⁰ ^eMake the heart of this people ^fdull,⁵ and their ears heavy, and blind their eyes;

^glest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed.”

Matthew 13:13-15

¹³ This is why I speak to them in parables, because ^bseeing they do not see, and hearing they do not hear, ^cnor do they understand. ¹⁴ Indeed, in their case the prophecy of Isaiah is fulfilled that says:

^d“ ‘ “You will indeed hear but never understand, and you will indeed see but never perceive.”

¹⁵ For this people’s heart has grown dull, and with their ears ^ethey can barely hear, and ^ftheir eyes they have closed, lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears and ^gunderstand with their heart and ^hturn, and I would heal them.’
