Genesis 28:15	Behold I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you.
Exodus 15:26	For I am the Lord, who heals you....
Joshua 1:9	Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.
II Chronicles 20:17	Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow and the Lord will be with you.
Psalms 16:11 Psalms 23:1	You will make known to me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; in Your right hand there are pleasures forever. The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
Psalms 23:3a	He restores My soul...
Psalms 32:8	I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.
Psalms 37:23-24	The steps of a man are established by the Lord, and He delights in his way. When he falls, he will not be hurled headlong, because the Lord is the One who holds his hand.
Psalms 55:22	Cast your burden on the Lord, and He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to fall.
Psalms 56:3	When I am afraid I will trust in you.
Psalms 68:19	Blessed be the Lord, who daily bears our burden, the God who is our salvation.
Psalms 91:1	He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
Psalms 121:4	Behold, He who keeps Israel (insert my name or others) will neither sleep nor slumber.
Psalms 130:5	I wait for the Lord, my soul does wait, and in His word do I hope.
Psalms 145:18	The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth.
Proverbs 3:5 & 6	Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not rely on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will make your paths straight.
Proverbs 18:10	The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous runs into it and is safe.

Isaiah 40:28-31	Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable. He gives strength to the weary, and to him who lacks might He increases power. Though youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly, yet those who wait for the Lord will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary.
Isaiah 41:10	Do not fear, for I am with you. Do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.
Isaiah 48:17	Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel, "I am the Lord your God, who teaches you to profit, who leads you in the way you should go."
Isaiah 66:12	For thus says the Lord, "Behold, I extend peace to her like a river...."
Isaiah 54:10	"For the mountains may be removed and the hills may shake, but My lovingkindness will not be removed from you, and My covenant of peace will not be shaken," says the Lord who has compassion on you.
Jeremiah 29:11	"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans for welfare and not for calamity to give you a future and a hope." (New English Standard version says plans for wholeness and not for evil..)
Jeremiah 29:13-14	"You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you," declares the Lord.
Zephaniah 3:17	The Lord your God is in your midst, a victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will quiet you in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.
Matthew 11:28	Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest.
Matthew 28:20b	...and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of this age.
Luke 1:37	For nothing will be impossible with God.
Luke 1:45	Blessed is she who has believed that what the Lord has said to her will be accomplished.
John 8:12	I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in darkness, but will have the Light of Life.
John 10:11 & 14	I am the good shepherd, the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep... I am the good shepherd, and I know My own and My own know me.
John 15:11	These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full.
