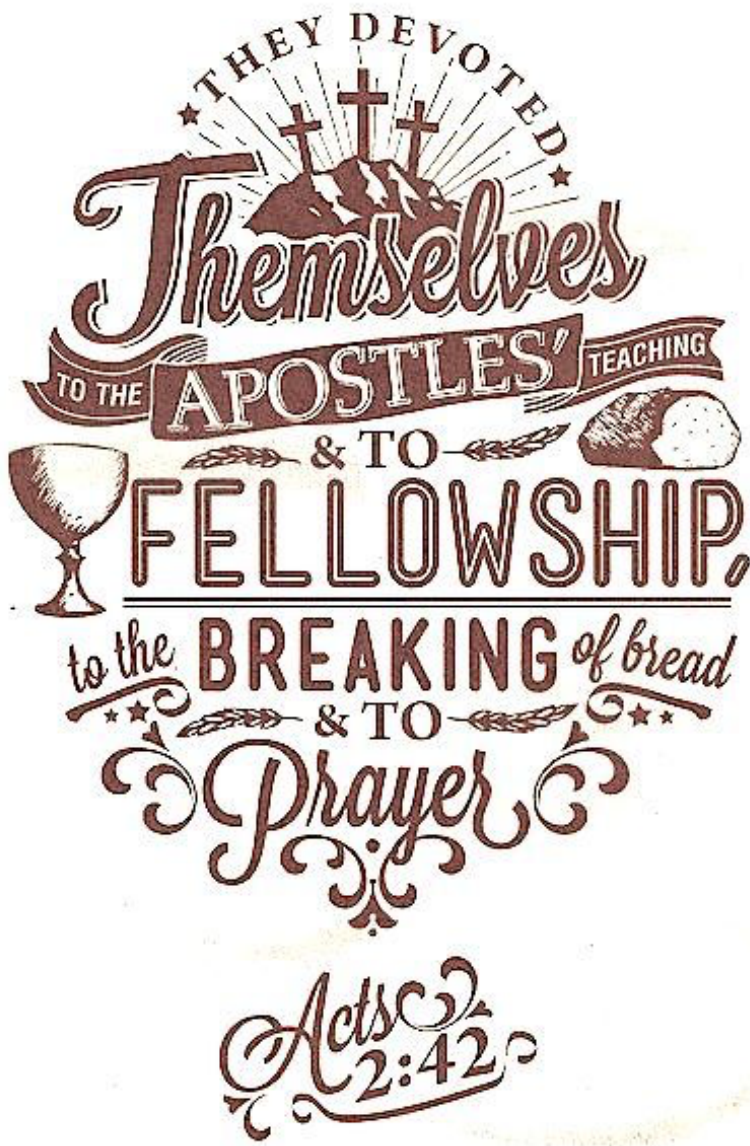


Romans 8:9–11

Do you not know that you³ are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?



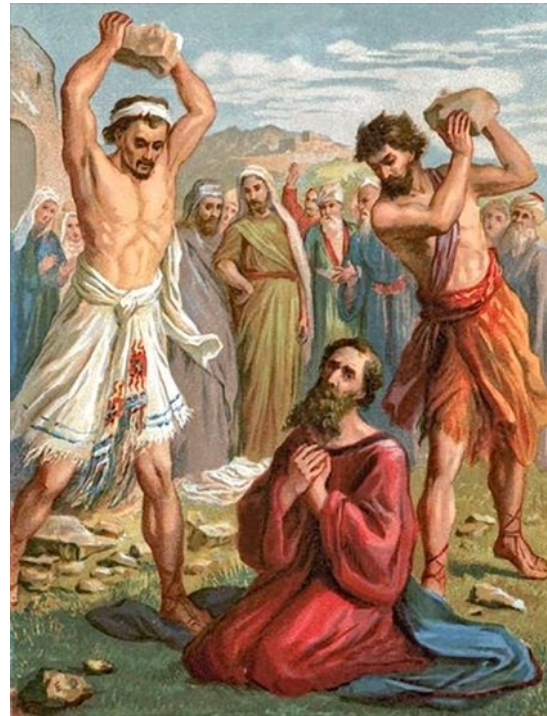
