Day 2

The theme of Titus is order in the church. Paul is counseling Titus on how to set up the churches by giving him the qualifications of the leadership. The responsibility for leadership was placed on the shoulders of qualified elders; however, everyone in the body was to approach his or her walk with God with seriousness and commitment. As we look at these qualifications, it is good to look at ourselves in relationship to these traits whether we are in leadership roles or not.

List the traits from Titus 1:6-9. If there are ones you personally struggle with, ask the Lord to strengthen and guide you to correct them. Conversely, with thanksgiving, praise God for those He has helped you attain.

Day 3

Paul believed that doctrine must be expressed in life, and so he had a word to Titus about the aged (2:2-3), the youth (2:4-6) and the slaves (2:9-10).

What did Paul say must be taught to each group?

Day 4

We know that we are not saved by good works, but we are saved unto good works out of love and appreciation for what God has done for us through His son. Paul says we are saved by His mercy (3:5), and justified by His grace (3:7). Because we have been saved at such a cost, we should show it by “good works”. How does Paul describe these in chapter 3?
